Rules & Regulations

Eligibility

All rules and regulations listed are subject to each angler and are strictly enforced. Any person who operates the combustion engine must be 18 years of age or older. Minors are welcome to participate only under the full responsibility of an adult partner. All competitors MUST have a valid fishing license. All State and local laws apply.

Interpretation of Rules

The Tournament Director (s) is responsible for interpretation of all rules and regulations. In any event, the Tournament Director (s) shall have the final decision in all matters. The Tournament Director (s) may impose, but is not limited to, disqualifications, forfeiture of prizes and or entry fee and can prohibit competitors in future tournaments as deemed necessary. The Tournament Director (s) reserves the right to refuse any angler registration for the tournament.

Sportsmanship and Rules of Conduct

All Contestants shall conduct themselves professionally at all times toward all persons and are expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship, safety and conservation. All contestants must keep the waters clean and bring trash back for proper disposal. All competitors shall not act unfavorably on the sport of bass fishing. Being under the influence of drugs or alcohol is strictly prohibited. Any competitor who violates such rules will be disqualified. Issues of misconduct should be immediately brought to the attention of the Tournament Director.

Boat Equipment and Safety

Extreme caution must be exercised at all times. Contestants understand that fishing in an open boat can be dangerous and that safe boating conduct is vital for competitors and non-competitors alike. All boats, drivers, and passengers will accept full responsibility for any and all personal injury and all property damage that may occur.

Registration

Competitors may register by mail, telephone, online, or in person at the tournament site. Boat numbers are determined using the "first in, first out" method according to when registration entries are received. Anglers may choose to fish individually. All boats will be checked prior to the rules briefing. Competitors who do not check in will be disqualified. Tournament fees are payable by cash, check, or money order and must be paid at time of registration. Checks must be received 7 days prior to tournament date. Competitors who choose to register at the ramp can do so with cash only. Refunds will be given only in the event of a canceled tournament. Returned checks may disqualify anglers from future tournaments. Returned Check fees of \$35.00 will be enforced.

Emergencies

During tournament hours, all competitors shall remain in their boats at all times with the exception of severe weather, other such hazards, and emergencies. One team member is allowed to exit temporarily for the purpose of refueling, sickness, call of nature, lure retrieval, and boat repair. Competitors may not exit the boat to land a fish or make the boat more accessible to fishing waters. Failure to abide by these rules will result in disqualification.

Off Limits

Areas marked "No Fishing" by local or state governments shall be off limits to fishing. Any additional off limits areas will be established before blast off.

Tournament Hours

Hours of competition will be from safeligh. conditions permitting, until weigh in beginning at 3:00pm. Weigh in may be held in flights.

Tackle and Fishing Methods

Only artificial lures may be used. All bass must be caught in a legal, live and conventional manner using a rod and reel. Only one rod and reel combination may be used at one time. Trolling as a method of fishing is prohibited. When sight fishing for a bedding bass, the fish must be hooked in the mouth or released immediately. Fishing on tournament waters is not permitted within 50 yards of another competitor's boat, if it is anchored with the trolling motor up.

Weigh In

The first flight shall check in by 3:00pm and each following flight shall check in at their appointed time. If any competitor's boat is removed from the water prior to weigh in, that team shall be disqualified. Should an emergency or equipment failure occur, the competitor should contact the tournament director via phone and approve a water tow with their catch in their live well or be transported by an approved individual with the catch and one team member remaining with the boat. Late penalties will be enforced. Competitors who are late for weigh in will be penalized with a deduction of one (1) pound per minute late from their total weight for the day. Team members who leave the tournament before weigh in must check in with Tournament Officials.

Protest and Polygraph Screenings

By entering said tournament, contestants agree to submit to a polygraph/voice test examination should the competitor be accused of any rule violation. Protests may be registered in person after the rules briefing before boat launch or after weigh in and before awards are presented. Any person failing to successfully pass a polygraph/voice test in this or any other tournament will not be allowed entry into future KofC Assembly 3199 Bass Tournaments. All contestants agree that in the event of a dispute or protest of any kind, or if requested to do so by the TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR, both team members will submit to a polygraph screening. The administration and interpretation of the polygraph/voice test shall be the responsibility of the Tournament Director (s) or agents. The Tournament Director will choose the individual who administers such polygraph/voice test, and the scope of the questions, which may be asked during such test and schedule a polygraph session at the place of Tournament Director's choice. Protests must be accompanied by \$100.00 cash. If the protest is valid, the protester shall receive a refund of the \$100.00 protest fee. Contestants further agree that the results of the polygraph screening will be accepted without further appeal and will be the final decision in said tournament. All contestants agree and understand that Protested prizes will be held until the polygraph results are received and any differential in awards will be mailed to affected winners immediately following results. Both team members hereby waive and release any and all claims and causes of action against KofC Assembly 3199 employees, sponsors, and their agents and employees, in connection with taking such polygraph screenings. In the event of no polygraph screening, the Tournament Director's decision will be accepted. Inconclusive results on a polygraph examination will be considered to be a failure to pass and will be accepted as such by the examinee.

Waiver of Liability

Upon entrance of tournament, all competitors release any and all sponsors, directors, officials, organizations, hosts, and locations affiliated with any KofC Assembly 3199 tournament from liability for any occurrence resulting from tournament participation. Should a suit be filed against KofC Assembly 3199 or any affiliated parties, all court costs and attorney's fees shall be paid by the plaintiff (competitor). All competitors must agree to understand and follow ALL rules and waivers to be entered into said tournament.
